Beijing Paralympic Games 2008

Games Ticket Order Factsheet

The 13th Paralympic Games will be held in Beijing, China, from 6 to 17 September, 2008. As the capstone of all sporting events, the Beijing 2008 Paralympic Games will be expecting a congregation of over 4000 world-class athletes. These sportsmen have proven themselves as the strongest contenders to qualify for this exalted event. Singapore is looking to qualify & participate in four sport disciplines namely, athletics, swimming, sailing and equestrian events. With six months to go until the Paralympic games, the host country is seeking pre-orders for Paralympic Games Ticket. Ticket Orders for each country are placed through its country's National Paralympic Committee and the Singapore Disability Sports Council is currently collecting interest for the Games Ticket in the above-mentioned sports.

1.0 Ticket Type

There will be six types of ticket configuration for the Beijing Paralympic Games:

1.1 Ceremonies Ticket

All Opening & Closing Ceremony Tickets are printed on special Beijing 2008 commemorative paper material which will provide lasting keepsake of the Beijing 2008 Paralympic Games. For these the Paralympic Games will carry on the "real name policy" in the ticket purchasing and entry in order to guarantee spectators security. The ID and photo of every ticket will need to be submitted at a later date when informed by SDSC. Any fake or late entry will not lead to entry into the venues, since the mismatching information refuses you to go through the Ticket Monitoring System.

1.2 Sports Tickets

-Olympic Green Day Pass

Seven venues are located in the Olympic Green, namely, National Stadium, National Indoor Stadium, National Aquatics Center, the Fencing Hall, Olympic Green Archery Field, Olympic Green Tennis Center and Olympic Green Hockey Field. 9 sports will be hosted in Olympic Green, including Athletics, Wheelchair Basketball, Swimming, Boccia, Wheelchair Fencing, Archery, Wheelchair Tennis, Football 7-a-side and Football 5-a-side. The spectators who purchase the day pass will be allowed to sit in the general admission areas in every venue, but except high demand sessions. The ticket will be valid for 1 entry into Olympic Green for 1 day at the games, but multiple entry will be allowed into different venues in the Olympic Green in the same day. Please purchase this ticket, according to the number of days that you expect to attend at the Paralympic Games. Entry to the venue will be as general admission and is subject to availability of seats at any given time. Therefore entry to a venue is in a first come—first served basis and Spectator Service staff may temporarily reject entries based on the attendance rate, or allow ticket holders to enter the venue at a later time.

-Olympic Green High Demand Session Ticket

For the sessions that are considered high demand in the Olympic Green, spectators who purchase the respective type of tickets will be guaranteed a specific numbered seat in the sport session corresponding to their ticket. High Demand Sessions requires High Demand Tickets to enter. Olympic Green Day Pass will not be valid for entry. The ticket will be valid for 1 entry into the Olympic Green, 1 entry into the high demand session venue.

Ticket Policy to Note:

- Sport Tickets can be legally transferred at face value or below.
- Lost or Stolen Tickets will not be replaced
- If a session changes its start or finish time, but its date remain unchanged, the ticket holders of this session will not receive replacement or reimbursement for their tickets. If a session is postponed or rescheduled for completion on another day, the ticket holders of the specific session can reserve their tickets. With the same tickets they can enter the venue on the designated day that the session will commence.

1.3 Sailing Tickets

The sailing events for the Paralympics Games will be held in Co-host cities: Qingdao, China within Qingdao International Sailing Center. Co-host city, Qingdao, is 1 hour away from Beijing via plane. Athletes compete in three Paralympic events, which are non-gender specified: the three person keelboat event, the two person keelboat event and the single person keelboat event. Full and Half Course Tickets are available for purchase. One ticket qualifies for entry into one day at the Qingdao Olympic Sailing Centre.

1.4 Equestrian

The equestrian events for the Paralympic Games will be held in Hong Kong, China. The Jump and the Dressage competitions will take place at Hong Kong Olympic Equestrian Venue (Shatin). Co-host city, Hongkong, is 4hours away from Beijing via plane. Dressage will be the only discipline for the equestrian competition in the 2008 Paralympic Games, including championship test, freestyle test and team test. More information about Equestrian ticket orders will be released once the Beijing Organizing Committee finalizes ticket prices and schedule.

Eligibility of Ticket Holder

Purchasers of the tickets need to be Citizens or Permanent Residents of Singapore due to territory restrictions that the Beijing Organizing Committee has stated.

Deadline for Ticket Orders

Ticket Orders for the Paralympic Games will end strictly on 14th March 2008. All Ticket Orders are to be placed through the Registration form attached and faxed to +65 6342 0961.

Ticket Allocation

If met with overwhelming ticket demand, ticket allocation will be subjected to a balloting process. For ticket order of sports outside the Olympic Green venues, please contact Eileen Seto at spex1@sdsc.org.sg

Payment Terms

Payment terms will be publicized at a later date by the Singapore Disability Sports Council for successful applicants.

Accommodation

All Ticket Holders need to arrange their own accommodation and flight into these cities. However, SDSC is in the process of collaborating with a local travel agency for a Paralympic package that will include flight and accommodation. When confirmed, details will be sent to all successful ticket holders.

Terms & Condition of Sale

1. Purchasers of the tickets need to be Citizens or Permanent Residents of Singapore.
2. Ticket Orders made cannot be cancelled, changed or refunded after 14th March 2008.
3. Ticket order prices are subjected to exchange rate fluctuations.
4. Prices of tickets are dependant on the category of the ticket seats.
5. Ticket purchased are not permitted for resale.
6. All personal information provided in this form has to be accurate and correct.
7. If met with overwhelming demand for tickets, Ticket Allocations will be subjected to a balloting process. Each person successful in the ballot is entitled to purchase maximum of one pair of Opening/Closing Ceremony Ticket.
8. Payment will be required upon confirmation of allocated tickets. Only cash and cheque payment will be accepted.
9. A 10% administrative fee would be levied over and above the price of the ticket.
