Team China Ascends Summit of IFDS WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP

Team China ascended to the summit of the team rankings after another day of consistent performances at the IFDS Two-Person Keelboat 2008 World Championship being held in Singapore. Team Singapore, who led the pack for the first two days of the races, slumped to third placing after finishing 6th and 5th in Race 7 and 8 held today.

Team Portugal could have so nearly finished ahead of eventual leaders China after winning Races 6 and 8. However, a blip in the form of a seventh place finish for Race 7 cost them dearly. They eventually finished the day in second place.

After three days of racing, Team China leads the pack with a point total of 13, with Team Portugal and Team Singapore close behind on 16 points and 18 points respectively.

The final results have been withheld, as one of the teams is seeking redress.

Races will take a break for tomorrow and resume on Thursday.
