A Journey of Triumph and Hope: The Story of Yip Pin Xiu & Raelynn Foo

Yip Pin Xiu's life has been profoundly transformed through sport. In a world where many families hesitate to let their children with disabilities pursue their passions, Pin Xiu's family was different. At five, after spending countless hours poolside in leg braces, Pin Xiu was finally granted her wish to join her brothers in the water. There, she discovered a liberating truth: in the water, she could still walk.

Each time Pin Xiu steps onto the podium, she feels immense gratitude for her family and supporters who have provided her with confidence and opportunities. Yet, she knows many individuals with disabilities have not been as fortunate. Pin Xiu hopes more people will join the effort to transform lives through sport.

Singapore Disability Sports Council (SDSC) has been crucial in Pin Xiu's journey. Our dedicated coaches, volunteers, donors, and partners have supported her training and competition, enabling her to achieve great success. Today, SDSC continues to help others discover their own triumphs through sport, whether through athletic achievements or improved physical and mental well-being.

Inspired by her experiences, Pin Xiu now serves on the SDSC board, aiming to assist more individuals with disabilities. She believes that with collective support, many more lives can be transformed through sport.

One such individual following in Pin Xiu's footsteps is Raelynn Foo, a promising ten-year-old swimmer. She recently won a gold medal at the National Para Swimming Championships & Inter-school Para Swimming Championships 2024. Raelynn is currently in the same para sport class (S2) as Pin Xiu, our five-time Paralympic gold medallist. Raelynn's success highlights the importance of family, community, and donor support in nurturing future athletes. Just as Pin Xiu's journey was made possible through unwavering support, we must continue to inspire and support young talents like Raelynn.

As Mother Teresa said, "I alone can't change the world, but I can cast a stone across the water to create many ripples." With your support, we can ensure the legacy of athletes like Yip Pin Xiu continues, paving the way for future champions like Raelynn.

A Journey of Perseverance and Inspiration: The Story of Aloysius Gan and Janell Lim

Aloysius Gan, born with dyskinesia cerebral palsy, faces challenges with joint movement and muscle strength, requiring the use of a motorised wheelchair for mobility and an assistive speech device for effective communication. Despite these physical impairments, Aloysius's courage and perseverance have proven to be boundless.

At the age of 7, Aloysius discovered his passion for boccia, a precision ball sport designed for individuals with severe physical disabilities, when a teacher from the Cerebral Palsy Alliance Singapore School introduced the game to him. From being a young boy who cried when he lost his first community tournament, Aloysius has transformed into a leader and an inspiration for his peers, mentoring his juniors and embracing the sport wholeheartedly.

Aloysius's dedication to boccia has yielded remarkable results. He represented Singapore with utmost pride as the flag bearer at the Bahrain 2021 Asian Youth Para Games, where he clinched a gold medal in the BC3 Individual event and a silver medal in the BC3 Mixed Pair event. These achievements marked Singapore's first-ever boccia medals at the Asian Youth Para Games, a testament to his hard work and determination.

Aloysius's journey has inspired many, including Janell Lim from AWWA. At the age of 13, Janell experienced a sudden attack of neuromyelitis optica, which significantly affected her mobility. Despite these challenges, she has shown immense resilience. Janell tried various sports, including badminton and wheelchair rugby, before discovering boccia. In early 2024, AWWA held a "Learn to Play Boccia" session, and Janell decided to take part. She continued to train diligently, leading to her participation in the Tiger Balm National Boccia Championships 2024, where she won a silver medal in her first competition.

By sharing the stories of Aloysius and Janell, we highlight the transformative power of sport and the importance of collective support in enabling individuals with disabilities to achieve their dreams. Together, we can create a more inclusive and empowering environment for all athletes, ensuring that the legacy of champions like Aloysius Gan paves the way for future stars like Janell Lim.
